BTSA - Brevet de technicien supérieur LANDSCAPING Level 5

The BTSA (Brevet de Technicien Supérieur Agricole) is a post A-Levels training course for two years (from September to June) providing technological and vocational skills. At ECOLE DU BREUIL you can prepare a BTSA – specialized in «landscaping», by school or apprenticeship branch



The training for the Agricultural Technician's Certificate (BTSA) in Landscaping provides scientific and technical knowledge. It provides methodological tools to design, build and maintain green spaces and to provide management functions.

GRADUATION

The diploma is obtained, for 50% of the grade, through continuous assessment and for 50 % in national 3 final exams:

- a general, socio-economic and cultural test
- a professional test,
- the presentation of the internship file/report.

ADMISSION

Prerequirements (school)

- high school diploma required
- The most suitable channels: technological education (STAV bac), general education, landscaping vocational diploma .

Prerequirements (apprenticeship)

- Holder of a level 4 diploma registered in the RNCP or a DAEU (diploma of access to University studies) or a higher level diploma registered in the RNCP
- Have signed an apprenticeship contract

AGE

- Between 16 and 23 years old on January 1st of the year of recruitment (school).
- Aged 16 to 29 at the time of signing the contract (apprenticeship)

APPLICATION PROCESS (FOR FRENCH STUDENTS)

School and apprenticeship

- Calendar available from mid-January, on www.parcoursup.fr (or on www.ecoledubreuil.fr for some learners by apprenticeship)
- A motivation interview can be conducted

ALLOCATED PLACES: up to 28 (school) up to 24 (apprenticeship)

DURATION: 2 years

TRAINING STRUCTURE

Apprenticeship:

At the training center: 1350 hours of training over 2 school years (38 weeks) Alternating rhythm: 2 weeks in the company and 2 weeks at the CFA, with a minimum of 5 weeks of vacations

School:

15 weeks of internship over the 2 years.
