

# BTSA - BREVET DE TECHNICIEN SUPÉRIEUR

## LANDSCAPING

Level 5



*A two-year technical degree (from September to June) providing technological and vocational skills*

*With formal study of plant science, design, business management, ecological and sustainable ways to install and maintain landscapes*

*Combining paid on-the-job training (in apprenticeship) or internship periods (as a student)*

*A Nationally Recognised Qualification (RNCP 17218)*

### ADMISSION

#### Prerequisites (students)

- High school diploma required.
- The most suitable diploma: technological education (STAV bac), general education, landscaping vocational diploma.

#### Prerequisites (apprentices)

- diploma registered in the RNCP (Level4) or a DAEU (diploma of access to University studies) or a higher level diploma registered in the Register of national Qualifications RNCP
- Have signed an apprenticeship contract

#### Âge

- Between 16 and 23 years old on January 1st of the year of recruitment (students).
- Aged 16 to 29 at the time of signing the contract (apprentices)

#### Application process (for French students and apprentices)

- Calendar available from mid-January, on [www.parcoursup.fr](http://www.parcoursup.fr) (or on [www.ecoledubreuil.fr](http://www.ecoledubreuil.fr) for some learners by apprenticeship)
- An interview can be conducted

#### Duration :

2 years

### TRAINING STRUCTURE

#### Apprenticeship :

Apprenticeship:

At the training center: 1350 hours of training over 2 school years (38 weeks)

Alternating rhythm: 2 weeks in a company and 2 weeks in classroom instruction, with a minimum of 5 weeks of vacations

School:

15 weeks of internship over the 2 years.
