ADMISSION

Prerequirements (students)

- High school diploma required.
- The most suitable diploma: technological education (STAV bac), general education, landscaping vocational diploma.

Prerequirements (apprentices)

- diploma registered in the RNCP (Level4) or a DAEU (diploma of access to University studies) or a higher level diploma registered in the Register of national **Oualifications RNCP**
- Have signed an apprenticeship contract

- Between 16 and 23 years old on January 1st of the year of recruitment (students).
- Aged 16 to 29 at the time of signing the contract (apprentices)

- Calendar available from mid-January, on www.parcoursup.fr (or on www.ecoledubreuil.fr for some learners by apprenticeship)
- An interview can be conducted
